## **The Campus Ministry Team of the NC Synod will...**

- Assist and support the church's ministry in institutions of higher education on the synodical territory.
- Be responsible for sharing financial resources from the synodical budget to those ministries.
- Serve as a conduit between Region Nine/Churchwide Organization (including but not limited to LuMin) and the campus ministries of the NC Synod.

## **Job Description for Team Members**

- To engage in this work through the synod's core values: Jesus, Generosity, Relationship and Reconciliation.
- To be a person of prayer who is knowledgeable about and supportive of this synod's campus ministries.
- To be passionate about ministry to young adults.
- To participate fully in meetings and follow-up tasks.

## **Team Member Commitment**

This team will meet two times a year. The Fall meeting is usually held at one of the campus ministry sites and the Spring meeting is conducted in an online format. The Fall meeting will include conversation about the sharing of synodical dollars to each ministry from the campus ministry line item of the synodical budget. Members are appointed by the Synod Council. Terms generally last for 3 years with initial members being assigned staggered terms. Members can serve two consecutive terms. Ministry teams will generally be comprised of 4-8 people and strive for diversity.

## **Goals**

For 2022-2023, the Campus Ministry Team will work to:

- Connect with each of our 13 ministries to provide support and guidance as needed.
- Secure from congregations the names of Lutheran students attending institutions of higher education on the synodical territory and share those names with the appropriate campus minister.
- Engage in a comprehensive conversation and study about the history of funding in the NC Synod and how the synodical resources might be stewarded and shared in an appropriate way.

This team's work may conclude in consultation with the Bishop, synod staff liaison, and the ministry team co-chairs.
