

Synod Council Highlights—June 2, 2023 abbreviated pre-Assembly meeting

The council approved:

- recommending to Synod Assembly that Christ's Beloved Community, Winston-Salem, be received as a congregation.
- two rostered ministers' transitions.
- Michael Peeler/Virginia Casey Fund grants totaling \$709,185.
- reinvesting money currently invested in the ELCA Mission Investment Fund (MIF) as follows: \$1,000,000 to the Synod Foundation, and \$280,000 back into MIF.

The council also received:

- a report of the closing of South Durham Connections Mission (Park Town Food Hub will continue).
- a Finance & Property Committee report including the complete spending of the COVID Fund (initially \$750,000).
- the Audit Committee report that the 2022-2023 Audit Report was received and approved—a "clean" report.

The NC Synod Council will next meet in retreat at Lutheridge, September 14-16, 2023.
