**Plan and Prepare:** Will plan and prepare music in advance of rehearsals and worship services. Will be responsible for regular copyright reporting.

Conduct Practices: Will lead rehearsals for the choir except during the month of July.

**Direct Choir:** Will direct the choir and congregation in weekly worship as well as Ash Wednesday, Lent, Holy Week, Christmas, Campfire Worship, and special services to be determined, planned, and agreed upon in advance.

**Coordinate Schedule:** Will determine and coordinate music program and schedules with relevant people (pastor, musicians, Worship & Music Committee, Christian Education Committee, church secretary, special events coordinators, project leaders for community worship events, etc.).

Attend Worship & Music Committee Meetings: Will meet with Worship & Music Committee as scheduled unless the need arises for a called meeting (advanced notice will be given).

**Special Events:** Will be available to help with Vacation Bible School and Joint Choir Cantata as needed.

**Continuing Education:** Will be given opportunities to attend available workshops and seminars such as (but not limited to) Lutheridge Music Week, Small Choir Workshops, etc.
