

The Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd in Brevard, North Carolina seeks a part time keyboardist (piano and organ) to perform music for its 10:30 service, accompany choir rehearsals, play for special services, and collaborate with church staff to plan for worship. The congregation values music as an essential part of worship, and is supportive and appreciative of our musical staff and volunteers. The ideal candidate will be someone with a collaborative spirit who will join, and engage with, enthusiastic music makers. The sanctuary has a Yamaha grand piano, a small, single manual Casavant pipe organ, and a 3 manual electronic Allen organ.

Duties:

- Choose and perform music for the 10:30 a.m. service and accompany hymns, liturgy, and any special music.
- Accompany Advent and Lenten services, including Ash Wednesday, seasonal midweek services, and Holy Week services.
- Accompany choir rehearsals.
- Perform or find a substitute organist or pianist for funerals and weddings. (Compensation for these events is outside the usual compensation package.)
- Collaborate with staff and lay leadership to plan worship.

Compensation:

- \$18,200 per year
