



Syllabus—Revelation Bible Study

- March 13—Session 1: *Introduction and the Seven Churches* Revelation, chapters 1-3
Focuses on John's vision, the introduction to the book, and the messages to the seven churches in Asia Minor, highlighting their strengths and weaknesses as a reflection on the early Church.
- March 20—Session 2: *The Heavenly Throne Room and the Scroll* Revelation, chapters 4-5
Explores the vision of the heavenly throne room, the description of God's majesty, and the mystery of the sealed scroll, which represents God's plan for history and the coming judgment.
- March 27—Session 3: *The Seals and Trumpets* Revelation, chapters 6-11
Delves into the visions of the seven seals and the seven trumpets, signifying increasing cosmic disturbances and judgments as the end times approach.
- April 3—Session 4: *The Bowls and the Beast* Revelation, chapters 12-19
Examines the conflict between good and evil, the woman clothed with the sun (representing the Church), the dragon (Satan), and the rise of the "Beast" who deceives the world.
- April 10—Session 5: *The New Heaven and New Earth* Revelation, chapters 20-22
Concludes with the vision of the new creation, the final judgment, and the eternal state of the redeemed in the new heaven and new earth.
