



URGENT: Help LSC Support Refugees in Crisis

Lutheran Services Carolinas (LSC) urgently needs our support! Last week, LSC—along with all other refugee resettlement agencies—received a directive to cease all federally funded work with refugees. Since October, LSC’s **New Americans Program** has welcomed nearly **400 refugees** to the Carolinas, helping them rebuild their lives with dignity and hope. Now, just days or weeks after arriving in the U.S., many of these individuals and families are at risk of losing critical support.

We cannot abandon them now. Refugees come to our communities legally, fleeing violence and persecution. Without housing, employment assistance, and basic services, they face unimaginable hardship.
